A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT ALLOWING LICENSED CLINICAL ADDICTION SPECIALISTS TO FORM A PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION WITH A PHYSICIAN AND AUTHORIZING THE 3 4 SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO ALLOW LICENSED 5 PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS TO CONDUCT INITIAL (FIRST-LEVEL) 6 EXAMINATIONS FOR THE INVOLUNTARY COMMITMENT OF INDIVIDUALS 7 WITH A MENTAL ILLNESS OR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 55B-14(c)(4) reads as rewritten:

- 10 A physician, a licensed psychologist, a licensed clinical social worker, or "(4) each of them and a certified clinical specialist in psychiatric and mental 11 12 health nursing, a licensed marriage and family therapist, a licensed professional counselor, a licensed clinical addiction specialist, or each of 13 them, to render psychotherapeutic and related services that the respective 14 15 stockholders are licensed, certified, or otherwise approved to provide." 16
 - SECTION 2. G.S. 122C-263.1(a) reads as rewritten:

17 "(a) The Secretary of Health and Human Services may, upon request of an LME, waive 18 the requirements of G.S. 122C-261 through G.S. 122C-263 and G.S. 122C-281 through G.S. 122C-283 pertaining to initial (first-level) examinations by a physician or eligible 19 20 psychologist of individuals meeting the criteria of G.S. 122C-261(a) or G.S. 122C-281(a), as 21 applicable, as follows:

- 22 (1)The Secretary has received a request from an LME to substitute for a 23 physician or eligible psychologist, a licensed clinical social worker, a licensed professional counselor, a master's level psychiatric nurse, or a 24 25 master's level certified clinical addictions specialist in accordance with subdivision (8) of this subsection to conduct the initial (first-level) 26 27 examinations of individuals meeting the criteria of G.S. 122C-261(a) or 28 G.S. 122C-281(a). In making this type of request, the LME shall specifically 29 describe all of the following: 30
 - How the purpose of the statutory requirement would be better served a. by waiving the requirement and substituting the proposed change under the waiver.
 - How the waiver will enable the LME to improve the delivery or b. management of mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance abuse services.
