10	(6)	The defendant was incarcerated in a unit of the Division of Adult Correction
11		and Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public Safety and is serving a
12		sentence or in a unit of the Federal Bureau of Prisons located within the
13		borders of the State at the time of the failure to appear as evidenced by a copy
14		of an official court record or a copy of a document from the Division of Adult
15		Correction and Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public Safety or Federal
16		Bureau of Prisons, including an electronic record.
17	<u>(6a)</u>	The defendant was in the custody of the Division of Adult Correction and
18		Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public Safety or the Federal Bureau of
19		Prisons located within the borders of the State at any time between the failure
20		to appear and the final judgment as evidenced by a copy of an official court
21		record or a copy of a document from the Division of Adult Correction and
22		Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public Safety or Federal Bureau of
23		Prisons, including an electronic record."

28	(b) Reasons. – The court may grant the defendant or any surety named in the judgment	
29	relief from the judgment, for the following reasons, and none other: reasons:	
30	(1)	The person seeking relief was not given notice as provided in G.S. 15A-544.4.
31	(2)	Other-extraordinary circumstances exist that the court, in its discretion,
32		determines should entitle that person to relief.
