- and on page 4, lines 8-19, by rewriting the lines to read:
- 8 "(a4) Dismissal on or After July 1, 2020. If any person is charged with a misdemeanor or
- 9 felony, excluding any violation of the motor vehicle laws under Chapter 20 of the General
- 10 Statutes, and the charge is dismissed on or after July 1, 2020, the dismissed charge is expunged
- 11 by operation of law. The district attorney who filed the dismissal or judicial officer who ordered
- 12 the dismissal shall provide notice of the dismissal to the clerk.
- 13 (a5) Finding of Not Guilty on or After July 1, 2020. If any person is charged with a
- 14 misdemeanor or felony, excluding any violation of the motor vehicle laws under Chapter 20 of
- 15 the General Statutes, and a finding of not guilty is entered on or after July 1, 2020, the court that
- 16 entered the finding shall order the expunction from all official records any entries relating to
- 17 apprehension or trial of that crime. If a person is charged with multiple offenses and any charge
- 18 was not dismissed, the court shall hold a hearing to determine if the records of any charges
- 19 dismissed retain evidentiary value. If the court, after hearing, finds that all related criminal
- 20 charges have reached final disposition, the court may order the expunction of any charge that
- 21 <u>was dismissed.</u>".
