6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 15A-534 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
8	"(j) An order of pretrial release takes effect immediately and remains in effect until the		
9	9 charges are disposed of, regardless of whether a defendant is incarcerated or released."		
10	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 15A-534.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
11	"(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, at the initial appearance of a defendant		
12	2 <u>immediately following the defendant's arrest, a judicial official authorized by this Article to set</u>		
13	conditions of pretrial release may order that the defendant have no contact with the alleged victim		
14	4 <u>of the crime while the defendant awaits the determination of pretrial release conditions pursuant</u>		
15	15 to subsections (a) and (b)."		
16	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
