3	BUILDING RESERVE FOR CERTAIN BUILDING PROJECTS.			
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	SECTION 1.(a) By August 15, 2020, notwithstanding any provision of law to the			
6	contrary, (i) the Department of Administration shall transfer the sum of eight million five hundred			
7	thousand dollars (\$8,500,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year from the cash			
8	balance of the E-Commerce Reserve Fund (Budget Code: 24100; Fund Code: 2514) and (ii) the			
9	Department of Revenue shall transfer the sum of three million nine hundred ninety-one thousand			
10	five hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$3,991,578) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal			
11	year from the ca	sh balance of Revenue: Project Collect Tax (Budget Code: 24'	704; Fund Code:	
12	2474) to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina (Budget Code: 16011).			
13	The funds transferred in this section are hereby appropriated to the Board of Governors of The			
14	University of North Carolina for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be used for the Building Reserve			
15	to be allocated in accordance with subsection (c) of this section.			
16	SECTION 1.(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of			
17	Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred eighteen thousand two			
18	hundred eighty-nine dollars (\$118,289) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year for			
19	the Building Reserve to be allocated in accordance with subsection (c) of this section.			
20	SECTION 1.(c) The funds appropriated by this act to the Board of Governors of The			
21	University of North Carolina for the 2020-2021 fiscal year for the Building Reserve shall be			
22	allocated for the	operation and maintenance of building projects as follows:
