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1 moves to amend the bill on page 4, lines 17 - 24, by rewriting the lines to read: 2

"from charging actual costs for a service such as a background check."";

5 and on page 18, lines 34 - 40, by rewriting the lines to read:

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8 SECTION 4. Part I of this act becomes effective December 1, 2020, and applies to 9 applications for licensure received on or after that date. Part II of this act becomes effective when 10 at least 10 states have enacted the Interstate Compact for Audiology and Speech Pathology set 11 forth in Section 3 of this act. The North Carolina Board of Examiners for Speech and Language 12 Pathologists and Audiologists shall report to the Revisor of Statutes when the Interstate Compact 13 for Audiology and Speech Pathology set forth in Section 3 of this act has been enacted by the 10 14 member states. Part III of this act is effective when it becomes law.".
