the voting place due to that person being a law enforcement officer, first responder, correctional		
officer, or member of the military and appearing in the uniform required by that person's		
employer. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to allow denial of entry into the voting		
place due to attire when such denial is otherwise prohibited by law."
