A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT PROVIDING AN ADDITIONAL DEFENSE TO DRIVING WITH AN EXPIRED 3 LICENSE AND WAIVING THE LATE FEE FOR RENEWING AN EXPIRED 4 REGISTRATION FOR PERSONS DEPLOYED AS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED 5 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 **SECTION 1.(a)** G.S. 20-35 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 8 Defense for Deployed Member of the Armed Forces of the United States. - A person "(d) 9 may not be found responsible for driving a motor vehicle with an expired drivers license if, when 10 tried for that offense, the person provides verifiable written proof of deployment and establishes the following: 11 12 The person was deployed as a member of the Armed Forces of the United (1)States when the drivers license expired. 13 14 The person obtained a renewed drivers license within 30 days after returning (2)from deployment." 15 SECTION 1.(b) This section becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to 16 17 offenses committed on or after that date. 18 SECTION 2. G.S. 20-88.03 reads as rewritten: 19 "§ 20-88.03. Late fee; motor vehicle registration. Late Fee. - In addition to the applicable fees required under this Article for the 20 (a) registration of a motor vehicle and any interest assessed under G.S. 105-330.4, the Division shall 21 22 charge a late fee according to the following schedule to a person who pays the applicable 23 registration fee required under this Article after the registration expires: 24 If the registration has been expired for less than one month, a late fee of fifteen (1)25 dollars (\$15.00). 26 (2)If the registration has been expired for one month or greater, but less than two months, a late fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00). 27 If the registration has been expired for two months or greater, a late fee of 28 (3)twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). 29 Waiver. - The Division shall waive the late fee assessed under subsection (a) of this 30 (a1) section against a person who establishes the following: 31 32 The person was deployed as a member of the Armed Forces of the United (1)33 States when the registration expired. 34 The person obtained a renewed registration within 30 days after the (2) 35 deployment ended.
