2	or mandate that any person receive a vaccination by operation of executive order. Any person				
3	who refuses to receive a vaccination under this section shall not be subject to civil or criminal				
4	liability for the refusal of vaccination.

16	SECTION 1.2.(b) This section applies to proposed rules published in the North				
17	Carolina Register and proposed rules posted on the website of the Office of Administrative				
18	Hearings on or after October 1, 2021.				
19	SECTION 1.3. Notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 130A or Chapter 166A of				
20	the General Statutes or any other provision of law to the contrary, no public health authority in				
21	the State, including the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services, the State				
22	Health Director, the Commission for Public Health, or the director of any local health department,				
23	may issue an order requiring any individual to submit to a COVID-19 vaccination or series of				
24	vaccinations.				
25	SECTION 2. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes				
26	law.
