G.S. 14-362 reads as rewritten: 7 "§ 14-362. Cockfighting. 8 A person who instigates, promotes, conducts, is employed at, allows property under his 9 ownership or control to be used for, participates as a spectator at, <u>causes a person under 18 years</u> of age to be present at, or profits from from, an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is 10 11 guilty of a Class I felony. A lease of property that is used or is intended to be used for an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is void, and a lessor who knows this use is made or is 12 13 intended to be made of his property is under a duty to evict the lessee immediately." 14 SECTION 2. G.S. 14-362.1 reads as rewritten: 15 "§ 14-362.1. Animal fights and baiting, other than cock fights, dog fights and dog baiting. 16 17 (c) A person who participates as a spectator at at, or causes a person under 18 years of 18 age to be present at, an exhibition featuring the fighting or baiting of an animal, other than a cock or a dog, is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor. 19" 20 21 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 14-362.2 reads as rewritten: 22 "§ 14-362.2. Dog fighting and baiting. 23 24 A person who participates as a spectator at at, or causes a person under 18 years of (c) 25 age to be present at, an exhibition featuring the baiting of a dog or the fighting of a dog with another dog or with another animal is guilty of a Class H felony. 26 27" 28 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses 29 committed on or after that date.
