5	SECTION 1. G.S. 163-278.11(b) reads as rewritten:
6	"(b) Threshold for Reporting Identity of Contributor. – A treasurer shall not be required
7	to report the name, address, or principal occupation of any individual who contributes fifty dollars
8	(\$50.00) one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or less to the treasurer's committee during an election as
9	defined in G.S. 163-278.13. The State Board of Elections shall provide on its reporting forms for
10	the reporting of contributions below that threshold. On those reporting forms, the State Board
11	may require date and amount of contributions below the threshold, but may treat differently for
12	reporting purposes contributions below the threshold that are made in different modes and in
13	different settings."
14	SECTION 2. G.S. 163-278.14 reads as rewritten:
15	"§ 163-278.14. No contributions in names of others; no anonymous contributions;
16	contributions in excess of fifty-one hundred_dollars; no contribution without
17	contributions in excess of fifty <u>one hundred</u> dollars; no contribution without specific designation of contributor.
