G.S. 14-415.10 reads as rewritten: 8 "§ 14-415.10. Definitions. 9 The following definitions apply to this Article: 10 . . . Qualified former sworn law enforcement officer. - An individual who retired 11 (4)12 from service as a law enforcement officer with a local, State, campus police, or company police agency in North Carolina, other than for reasons of mental 13 14 disability, who has been retired as a sworn law enforcement officer two years 15 or less from the date of the permit application, and who satisfies all of the 16 following: 17 Immediately before retirement, the individual was a qualified law a. 18 enforcement officer with a local, State, or company police agency in 19 North Carolina. 20 The individual has a nonforfeitable right to benefits under the b. retirement plan of the local, State, or company police agency as a law 21 enforcement officer; or has 20 or more aggregate years of law 22 23 enforcement service and has retired from a company police agency 24 that does not have a retirement plan; or has 20 or more aggregate years 25 of part-time or auxiliary law enforcement service. The individual is not prohibited by State or federal law from receiving 26 c. 27 a firearm. 28 Qualified probation or parole certified officer. - An individual employed as a (4a) 29 State probation or parole certified officer who meets all of the following 30 criteria: 31 The individual is authorized by the Division of Community <u>a.</u> Supervision and Reentry of the Department of Adult Correction to 32 33 carry a handgun in the course of duty. The individual is not the subject of a disciplinary action by the 34 <u>b.</u> Division of Community Supervision and Reentry of the Department 35 36 of Adult Correction that prevents the carrying of a handgun.
