10	including	the loca	ation of property corners, boundary lines, rights-of-way, and easements, and
11	may carry	with th	em their customary equipment and vehicles. An entry by a professional land
12	surveyor t	o perfor	m the practice of land surveying under this section shall not constitute trespass
13	under Arti	icle 22A	or 22B of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes or shall cause the professional
14	land surve	yor to b	be subject to arrest or a civil action by reason of the entry.

31			enclosed by a fence or other physical barriers that is obviously designed to
32			exclude intruders or clearly marked with a sign or signs posted on the property
33			that are reasonably likely to come to the attention of a person and indicate that
34			entry is forbidden without site authorization.
35		<u>(3)</u>	Professional land surveyor As defined in G.S. 89C-3, including any agents,
36			employees, or personnel under their supervision."
