9 **"SECTION 9D.22.(c)** Services Covered. – The clinical coverage policy developed in
10 accordance with this section shall provide Medicaid coverage of the following services in an
11 acute care hospital setting when medically necessary and ordered by a physician or other
12 appropriate provider:

13 ...

14 Services developed in accordance with this subsection shall be considered outpatient services.
15 Other ancillary services, such as laboratory services, imaging, and prescription drugs, shall
16 continue to be billed as separate and additional services not included as part of this new Medicaid
17 coverage. Notwithstanding G.S. 108D-35, any new services developed in accordance with this
18 subsection shall be limited to beneficiaries enrolled in NC Medicaid Direct or in a BH IDD
19 tailored plan, as defined in G.S. 108D-1. Standard benefit plans, as defined in G.S. 108D-1, shall
20 not be required to cover these newly developed services."; and

22 on page 172, lines 21-22, by inserting the following between the lines:

24 "(9) A representative of a prepaid health plan that is under a capitated contract with
25 the Department for the delivery of Medicaid services, as selected by the North
26 Carolina Association of Health Plans."; and

28 on page 270, lines 27-40, by rewriting the lines to read:

29 **"SECTION 14.9.(a)** Funds appropriated in this act to the Department of Natural and
30 Cultural Resources (the Department) for America's 250th Local Grants shall be used for a grant
31 program to facilitate participation in America's 250th anniversary activities, as set forth in this
32 section.

7 following title and description to read:
8 **"UNC – Children's Hospital**
9 Budgets receipts from the ARPA Temporary Savings Fund to the UNC Board of Governors for
10 UNC Health to construct, on behalf of the state of North Carolina, a new Children’s Hospital in
11 the Triangle area. The hospital will include a children’s behavioral health hospital. The total
12 authorized for the project is five hundred million dollars (\$500,000,000)."; and

14 and on page H9, Item 90, by reducing the requirements for the 2023-2024 fiscal year by seventeen
15 million dollars (\$17,000,000) in nonrecurring funds and reducing the requirements for the 2024-
16 2025 fiscal year by five million dollars (\$5,000,000); and

18 on page H12 by adding a new item for twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) nonrecurring in
19 requirements for the 2023-2024 fiscal year to read:
20 **"Crossroads of America Economic Development Alliance**
21 Provides a grant to the I-95/I-40 Crossroads of America
22 Economic Development Alliance, Inc."; and

24 on page H12, by adding a new item for five million dollars (\$5,000,000) nonrecurring in
25 requirements for the 2023-2024 fiscal year and five million dollars (\$5,000,000) nonrecurring in
26 requirements for the 2024-2025 fiscal year to read:
27 **"North Carolina Sports Legacy Foundation**
28 Provides a grant to the North Carolina Sports Legacy
29 Foundation, a nonprofit corporation, for capital needs."; and

31 by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
