12 **"SECTION 6.9.(a)** G.S. 138A-22 reads as rewritten:
13 **"§ 138A-22. Statement of economic interest; filing required.**

15 (b1) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, covered persons subject to this Chapter
16 who are appointed to fill a vacancy in elective office may file a statement of economic interest
17 within 30 days after appointment to elective office.

18 ...
19 (f) A candidate for an office subject to this Article shall file the statement of economic
20 interest with the Commission ~~within 10 days of the filing deadline for the office the candidate~~
21 ~~seeks, no earlier than the first business day in January and no later than 45 days before the~~
22 primary. An individual nominated under G.S. 163-114 shall file the statement within three days
23 following the individual's nomination, or not later than the day preceding the general election,
24 whichever occurs first. An individual seeking to qualify as an unaffiliated candidate under
25 G.S. 163-122 shall file the statement of economic interest within three days of filing the petition
26 required under that section. An individual seeking to have write-in votes counted for that
27 individual in a general election shall file a statement of economic interest within three days of
28 the time the candidate files a declaration of intent under G.S. 163-123. A candidate of a new
29 party chosen by convention shall file a statement of economic interest within three days of the
30 time that the president of the convention certifies the names of its candidates to the State Board
31 of Elections under G.S. 163-98.

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1 (h) The State Board of Elections shall provide for notification of the statement of
2 economic interest requirements of this Article to be given to any candidate filing for nomination
3 or election to those offices subject to this Article and to any nominee under G.S. 163-114. Each
4 year, the Commission shall publish the date by which the statement of economic interest is to be
5 filed. In the year candidates file for office, the State Board of Elections shall notify candidates
6 filing for offices subject to this Article of the date published by the Commission.
7 (i) Within 10 days of the filing deadline for office of a covered person, the executive
8 director of the State Board of Elections shall send to the ~~State Ethics~~ Commission a list of the
9 names and addresses of each candidate who has filed as a candidate for office as a covered person.
10 Within five days of an individual otherwise qualifying to be on the ballot, the State Board of
11 Elections shall send notice of that qualification to the ~~State Ethics~~ Commission.
12"
13 **SECTION 6.9.(b)** This section is effective when it becomes law and applies to
14 statements of economic interest filed on or after that date."
