GOVERNOR ROY COOPER OBJECTIONS AND VETO MESSAGE:

Senate Bill 747, "AN ACT TO MAKE VARIOUS CHANGES REGARDING ELECTIONS LAW."

This legislation has nothing to do with election security and everything to do with Republicans keeping and gaining power. In working to erect new barriers for younger and nonwhite voters, many of whom use early voting and absentee ballots, this bill also hurts older adults, rural voters and people with disabilities. It requires valid votes to be tossed out if the post office delivers them even one minute after 7:30 p.m. on Election Day or if a computer rejects a signature. It encourages voter intimidation at the polls by election deniers and conspiracy believers. North Carolina has conducted fair and secure elections but this bill will block voters and their ballots unnecessarily.

Therefore, I veto the bill.
