4 **INCREASES**

5 **SECTION 1.7A.** Any receipts that are required to be used to pay the legislatively  
6 mandated salary increases and employee benefits increases provided in this act are appropriated  
7 up to the actual amount received for the 2024-2025 fiscal year.

9 **REVISE CERTAIN SUPPLANTING CRITERIA FOR SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FOR**  
10 **TEACHER COMPENSATION**

11 **SECTION 1.7B.** Section 7A.4 of S.L. 2023-134 reads as rewritten:

13 **SECTION 7A.4.(b)** Definitions. – As used in this section, the following definitions shall  
14 apply:

15 ...

16 (14) Supplant factor. – For each local school administrative unit ~~in each fiscal year~~  
17 ~~of the fiscal biennium, as follows:~~

18 a. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the total non-State funds expended for  
19 salary supplements for teachers in the 2020-2021 fiscal year divided  
20 by the total State and non-State funds expended for salaries for  
21 teachers in the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

22 b. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, the lesser of the following:

23 1. The total non-State funds expended for salary supplements for  
24 teachers in the 2020-2021 fiscal year divided by the total State  
25 and non-State funds expended for salaries for teachers in the  
26 2020-2021 fiscal year.

27 2. The total non-State funds expended for salary supplements for  
28 teachers in the 2021-2022 fiscal year divided by the total State  
29 and non-State funds expended for salaries for teachers in the  
30 2021-2022 fiscal year.

- 1       **SECTION 7A.4.(f1)** Nonsupplant Enforcement. – If the State Board of Education  
2 determines that a local school administrative unit has supplanted non-State funds in violation of  
3 subsection (f) of this section, the State Board of Education shall do the following:  
4           (1) For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, continue to allocate funds to the unit in  
5 accordance with subsection (c) of this section.  
6           (2) For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, do either of the following:  
7               a. If the unit can show that it has remedied the deficiency in funding,  
8               continue to allocate funds to the unit in accordance with subsection (c)  
9               of this section.  
10              b. If the unit cannot show that it has remedied the deficiency in funding,  
11              not allocate any funds under this section to the unit.  
12        ....".
