# Joint Conference Committee Report on the Disaster Recovery Act of 2024 - Part II

Senate Bill 743

October 24, 2024

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### 2XXXX-Hurricane Helene Disaster Recovery Fund

### Legislative Changes

<b>General Disaster</b>	Assistance
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#### State Matching Funds 1

S.L. 2024-51, The Disaster Recovery Act of 2024, allocated \$250 million to the Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management (NCEM), to provide the State match for federal disaster assistance programs. These funds will be used to match federal funding and will generate an estimated \$2.25 billion in federal receipts, assuming a 90/10 federal match rate.

S.B. 743 expands the use of the state matching funds and removes the language around the revolving loan program for units of local government. Additional funds for units of local governments' cash flow needs are included in a separate item in this report.

#### Additional State Matching Funds 2

Allocates additional funding to NCEM to provide State match for federal disaster assistance programs. Along with funding included in S.L. 2024-51, the total General Fund appropriation is \$325 million, and these funds will generate an estimated \$2.9 billion in federal receipts, assuming a 90/10 federal match rate.

#### State and Local Government Unmet Needs 3

Allocates funding to NCEM for state agencies and units of local government in counties with a federal disaster declaration due to Hurricane Helene for unmet needs not covered by insurance or available federal aid.

#### 4 **Technical Assistance for Local Governments**

S.L. 2024-51, The Disaster Recovery Act of 2024, allocated \$2 million to the Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM) to provide grants to the NC League of Municipalities, NC Association of County Commissioners, and NC Association of Regional Councils of Governments to provide technical assistance with federal financial aid applications.

S.B. 743 amends this item to expand the uses of funds to include planning and permitting assistance and to build capacity for building and trade inspections.

#### **Increased Technical Assistance to Local Governments** 5

Allocates additional funding to OSBM to provide grants to the NC League of Municipalities, NC Association of County Commissioners, and NC Association of Regional Councils of Governments to provide technical assistance with federal financial aid applications, support planning and permitting assistance, and build capacity for building and trade inspections.

### Education

#### 6 School Nutrition Employee Compensation

S.L. 2024-51, The Disaster Recovery Act of 2024, allocated \$16 million to the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) for the compensation of school nutrition employees in counties with a federal disaster declaration due to Hurricane Helene whose compensation would otherwise have been provided by school meal receipts as part of the National School Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program.

Visit NC will work with local businesses in its promotion of western NC tourism.

### 30 EDPNC Business Loss Assessment

Allocates funds to Commerce for its contract with EDPNC for EDPNC to conduct a business loss assessment in counties with a federal disaster declaration due to Hurricane Helene.
