- 11 "§ 14-34.5. Assault with a firearm on a law enforcement, probation, or parole officer, or on a member of the North Carolina National Guard, or on a person employed at 12 13 a State or local detention facility.
- 14 Any person who commits an assault with a firearm upon a law enforcement officer, (a) probation officer, or parole officer while the officer is in the performance of his or her duties is 15 guilty of a Class D felony. 16
- 17 Any person who commits an assault with a firearm upon a member of the North (a1) Carolina National Guard while the member is in the performance of his or her duties is guilty of 18 19 a Class D felony.
- 20 Anyone who commits an assault with a firearm upon a person who is employed at a (\mathbf{b}) 21 detention facility operated under the jurisdiction of the State or a local government while the employee is in the performance of the employee's duties is guilty of a Class D felony.any of the 22 23 following persons who are in the performance of their duties is guilty of a Class B1 felony:
- 24 (1)A law enforcement officer.
- 25 (2)A probation officer. 26
 - A parole officer. (3)
 - A member of the North Carolina National Guard. (4)
- An employee of a detention facility operated under the jurisdiction of the State 28 (5) 29 or a local government.
