#### "PROVIDE SMALL FARMERS IN NORTH CAROLINA GRANTS TO ENSURE THE FUTURE VIABILITY OF NORTH CAROLINA'S FAMILY FARMS

**SECTION 10.3.(a)** Findings and Purpose. – The General Assembly finds that decades of barriers to entry, rising land prices, and economic consolidation have led to the loss of millions of acres of land farmed by small farmers. The General Assembly further finds that financial assistance through targeted grants can help address disparities and contribute to the long-term success of small farmers. The purpose of this section is to support the viability and sustainability of small farmers in North Carolina by providing financial assistance to support these farmers.

**SECTION 10.3.(b)** Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read:

#### "Article 61B.

"Small Farmers Support Grant Program.

#### "§ 106-748. Definitions.

The following definitions apply in this Article:

- Commissioner. The Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services. (1)
- Department. The North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer (2) Services.
- Eligible individual. A resident of this State who meets all of the following (3) criteria:
  - Is at least 21 years of age. a.
  - b. Is a small farmer.
  - Had an annual income from farming operations for the preceding c. taxable year of at least one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more.
- Small farmer. A farmer with a gross cash farm income of one million dollars (4) (\$1,000,000) or less, as determined in a manner as the Department may specify.

#### "§ 106-749. Small Farmers Support Grant Program established.

Program Established. – The Small Farmers Support Grant Program (Program) is established within the North Carolina Department of Agriculture to support current small farmers
