1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO LIMIT LIABILITY FOR NONGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACTORS
3 WORKING WITH AND FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC AGENCIES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Article 31 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
6 a new section to read:

7 **"§ 143-300.1B. Limited liability for licensed nongovernmental contractors with agencies.**

8 (a) The following definitions apply in this section:

9 (1) Nongovernmental contractor. – Any corporation, organization, or association,
10 incorporated or otherwise, that is organized or operating in the State, or an
11 individual operating a facility licensed under Article 2 of Chapter 122C of the
12 General Statutes or Article 1A of Chapter 131D of the General Statutes.

13 (2) Public agency. – The Department of Health and Human Services and any
14 county or local agency administering programs of public assistance pursuant
15 to Chapter 108A of the General Statutes.

16 (b) Any nongovernmental contractor that contracts with the public agency for the
17 provision of services to minors may be held liable for injury or damage caused by the negligence
18 of the nongovernmental contractor but shall not be held liable for the injury or damage caused
19 by the negligence of the public agency, including any officer, employee, volunteer, or agent of
20 the public agency acting within the scope of their employment.

21 (c) The nongovernmental contractor and the public agency shall each bear the costs of
22 defending itself against their respective acts and omissions and claims arising from those acts
23 and omissions.

24 (d) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section, if a tort claim against
25 the nongovernmental contractor arises from or related to the performance of the contracted
26 services to minors, the nongovernmental contractor shall be subject to the monetary limits
27 equivalent to those for a public agency as provided for in G.S. 143-299.2. Any claim against the
28 nongovernmental contractor arising from the nongovernmental contractor's provision of the
29 contracted services to minors shall be filed with a court of competent jurisdiction and not before
30 the Industrial Commission."

31 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2025, and applies to claims
32 arising from acts or omissions occurring on or after that date and contracts entered into or
33 renewed on or after that date.
