(Public) Sponsors: Referred to: March 26, 2025 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO ENACT THE FARMERS PROTECTION ACT TO PREVENT 3 DISCRIMINATION IN FINANCING AGAINST FARMERS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** Article 6 of Chapter 53C of the General Statutes is amended by adding 6 a new section to read: 7 "§ 53C-6-21. Discrimination prohibited. 8 For purposes of this section, an "agriculture producer" is defined as follows: "A (a) 9 person or other entity engaged in the production of crops or livestock for commercial purposes." Prohibition. - It is unlawful for a bank to deny or cancel its service to an agriculture 10 (b) producer based, in whole or in part, upon the agriculture producer's greenhouse gas emissions, 11 use of fossil-fuel derived fertilizer, or use of fossil-fuel powered machinery. 12 Enforcement. - The Commissioner shall monitor for compliance with this section as 13 (c) 14 part of its recurring examinations of banks and may take enforcement actions against any banks that violate this section." 15 SECTION 2. G.S. 54B-78 reads as rewritten: 16 "§ 54B-78. (b) 33 SECTION 3. G.S. 54C-64 reads as rewritten: 34 "§ 54C-64. Prohibited practices. 35 (a) A person who that engages in any either of the following acts or practices is guilty of

8	enforcement authority described in G.S. 53C-6-21(c)."
