23 of loss, the funeral establishment may petition a court of competent jurisdiction who, upon
24 finding that granting the requested extension would not negatively affect the public health, safety,
25 and welfare, may grant an additional extension not to exceed three years from the date of loss or
26 one year from the date of the court's order, whichever is greater. If a funeral";
