by deleting those lines and substituting the following:

"AIDS DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY, FUNDING, AND REPORTING REQUIREMENT

SECTION 9H.2.(a) Effective July 1, 2025, the maximum adjusted gross income for the federally funded HIV Medication Assistance Program, known in this State as the North Carolina AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP), is increased to four hundred percent (400%) of the federal poverty level.

SECTION 9H.2.(b) Notwithstanding any provision of law or the Committee Report described in Section 45.2 of this act to the contrary, funds provided to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, in Budget Code 14430, Budget Fund 134600, are increased by the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium, to cover increased ADAP costs attributed to increasing the maximum adjusted gross income to four hundred percent (400%) of the federal poverty level; and funds provided to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, in Budget Code 14430, Budget Fund 133000, for Carolina Pregnancy Care Fellowship, a nonprofit corporation, are decreased by the sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium.

SECTION 9H.2.(c) Upon a determination by the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, that, in six months or less, it will no longer be feasible to operate the health insurance premium assistance program implemented within the North Carolina AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) on a cost-neutral basis or in a manner that achieves savings to the State, the Department shall submit a report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services notifying the Committee of this determination along with supporting documentation and a proposed course of action with respect to health insurance premium assistance program participants."; and

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moves to further amend the bill on page 268, lines 10-30,

by deleting those lines and substituting the following:
