"HVAC GRANT PROGRAM

4 **SECTION 7.47.** With funds appropriated for this purpose, the Department of Public 5 Instruction shall establish the heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) Grant Program 6 (Program) for the 2025-2026 fiscal year. The purpose of the Program is to provide grants to local 7 school administrative units for updates and maintenance for the HVAC systems in the local 8 school administrative unit. The maximum grant award is one million one hundred thousand 9 dollars (\$1,100,000) per local school administrative unit."; and

11 on page 222, lines 6-7, by inserting the following between the lines:

"TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP CASH BALANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FOR HVAC GRANT PROGRAM

15 **SECTION 8A.15.** Notwithstanding G.S. 115C-562.8(d), the Authority shall transfer 16 to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of one hundred twenty-five million dollars 17 (\$125,000,000) in nonrecurring funds from funds that were appropriated for the award of 18 opportunity scholarships pursuant to Part 2A of Article 39 of Chapter 115C of the General 19 Statutes and unexpended at the end of the 2024-2025 fiscal year. The Department shall allocate 20 these funds for the HVAC Grant Program.";
