1 moves to amend the bill on page 265, lines 5-23,
2 by deleting those lines and substituting the following:

3 "SECTION 9G.6.(d) Appropriation of Funds to the DMH/DD/SUS. – The State
4 Controller shall transfer from funds available in the Opioid Abatement Reserve to the Opioid
5 Abatement Fund the sum of thirty-eight million four hundred forty-two thousand seven hundred
6 ninety-five thousand dollars (\$38,442,795) for the 2025-2026 fiscal year and the sum of twelve
7 million eight hundred forty-two thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$12,842,795) for
8 the 2026-2027 fiscal year. The funds transferred are appropriated for the fiscal year in which they
9 are transferred to the DMH/DD/SUS, to be allocated as specified in the Committee Report
10 described in Section 45.2 of this act. Of the funds appropriated to the DMH/DD/SUS by this
11 subsection, the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) in nonrecurring funds and the sum of
12 (\$6,092,795) in recurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year; and the sum of six million
13 ninety-two thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$6,092,795) in recurring funds for the
14 2026-2027 fiscal year shall be allocated and used as follows:

- 15 (1) The sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds shall be
16 used by the DMH/DD/SUS to purchase 8-milligram intranasal opioid
17 antagonist, to reverse the effects of opioid overdose.
18 (2) The sum of four million dollars (\$4,000,000) in nonrecurring funds shall be
19 allocated as directed grants to the local management entities/managed care
20 organizations (LME/MCOs). These funds shall be distributed equally among
21 the LME/MCOs for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to be used to support opioid
22 remediation activities in Tier 1 and Tier 2 counties, as defined in
23 G.S. 143B-472.35(a2)(18).
24 (3) The sum of six million ninety-two thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars
25 (\$6,092,795) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal
26 biennium shall be allocated to single-stream funding.

27 SECTION 9G.6.(d1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary or the
28 Committee Report described in Section 45.2 of this act, the funds provided to the Department of
29 Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and
30 Substance Use Services, in Budget Code 14460, Budget fund 134202, are increased by the sum
31 of six million ninety-two thousand seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$6,092,795) in recurring
32 funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium for single-stream funding."; and



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on page 262, lines 26 through 27, by inserting the following between the lines:

"REDUCE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION TO SINGLE STREAM FUNDING

SECTION 9G.1A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or of the Committee Report referenced in 45.2 of this act to the contrary, the funds appropriated from in this act from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Use Services, to be used for single-stream funding are decreased by the sum of six million ninety-two thousand, seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$6,092,795) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium."; and

on page 262, lines 28 through 30, by deleting the lines and substituting the following:

"MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE TASK FORCE RESERVE FUND ADJUSTMENTS

SECTION 9G.2.(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law or of the Committee Report referenced in 45.2 of this act to the contrary, the funds appropriated from in this act from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Use Services, are increased by the sum of six million ninety-two thousand, seven hundred ninety-five dollars (\$6,092,795) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium. These funds shall be deposited in the Mental Health and Substance Use Task Force Reserve Fund established under Section 12F.3(b) of S.L. 2016-94.";

And by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
