moves to amend the bill on page 5, lines 39-46, by rewriting the lines to read:

"d. Five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to OSBM to the entities listed in this sub-subdivision in the following amounts to provide grants for technical assistance to units of local governments in the affected area with (i) federal financial aid applications, (ii) disaster recovery funding, (iii) support planning and permitting assistance, and (iv) building capacity for building and trade inspections. In providing this assistance, these entities shall prioritize grants to units of local government in counties with a population of less than 250,000 in the affected area. Any unit of local government that has received a separate allocation of federal aid through HUD for Hurricane Helene is not eligible for this funding.

1. Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to the North Carolina League of Municipalities.
2. Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners.
3. One million dollars (\$1,000,000) to the North Carolina Association of Regional Councils of Government."; and

on page 6, line 40, by replacing the word "Commerce" with the word "Revenue"; and

on page 6, line 42, by deleting the phrase "within the affected area"; and

on page 6, lines 44-45, by deleting the phrase "in the affected area"; and

on page 6, line 47, by replacing the word "Commerce" with the word "Revenue"; and

on page 7, line 8, by deleting the phrase "located in the affected area"; and

on page 7, line 15, by deleting the phrase "in the affected area"; and

on page 7, between lines 20-21, by inserting between those lines a new sub-subdivision to read:

2 Public Assistance Categories C through G."; and

4 on page 7, lines 22-25, by rewriting those lines to read "a grant under the Program. Prior to
5 awarding a grant to an applicant business, the Department shall verify the applicant's economic
6 loss."; and

8 on page 7, line 47, by replacing the word "Commerce" with the word "Revenue"; and

10 on page 12, lines 27-28, by inserting the following between the lines:

11 "SECTION 3.3. Eligibility for Federal Decentralized Wastewater Funding. -- The
12 following entities are eligible to apply for and receive a loan or grant from funds appropriated in
13 this act to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund for decentralized wastewater treatment systems:

- 14 (1) A local government unit or a nonprofit water corporation, as defined in
15 G.S. 159G-20.
16 (2) A Community Development Finance Institution or a nonprofit organization
17 that provides financing assistance to homeowners to repair or replace
18 decentralized wastewater systems in North Carolina.
19 (3) A district health department established under Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter
20 130A of the General Statutes."
