Senator Moffitt

1 moves to amend the bill on page 12, lines 32-43, by rewriting those lines to read:

2       "(1) Fifty percent (50%) for local school administrative unit capital outlay  
3       purposes, as defined in G.S. 115C-426(f), or to retire any indebtedness  
4       incurred by the County for these purposes, and for local school administrative  
5       unit operating expenses. Prior to any funds allocated under this subdivision  
6       being used for local school administrative unit operating expenses, the  
7       Buncombe County Board of Commissioners must provide the Buncombe  
8       County Board of Education and the Asheville City Board of Education the  
9       opportunity to present at a public meeting the impacts of not using those funds  
10      on school capital projects. The Commission shall serve in an advisory capacity  
11      to the Buncombe County Board of County Commissioners with respect to the  
12      use of funds under this subdivision for school capital outlay purposes by  
13      considering the capital needs of both the Buncombe County School System  
14      and the Asheville City School System, prioritizing those needs, and  
15      recommending projects to be funded. However, the use of funds under this  
16      subdivision shall not be under the control of the Commission and shall be  
17      determined by the Board of Commissioners.

18       (2) Fifty percent (50%) for any public purpose.

19       **SECTION 16.1.(c)** To the extent Buncombe County receives any federal or State  
20      disaster funding as revenue replacement, the county shall return a proportionate share of revenue  
21      replacement funds to the Commission up to the amount of diverted funds under this section. The  
22      proportionate share shall be equal to the amount of revenue replacement received divided by the  
23      County's total revenue loss multiplied by the amount of diverted funds. Any remaining funds  
24      shall be used for any purposes allowed by the granting entity. For purposes of this subsection,  
25      the following definitions apply:

26       (1) Revenue replacement. – Grant monies to compensate for tax or fee revenue  
27       lost as the result of the impacts of Hurricane Helene to the extent the monies  
28       are unrestricted in use and available for any public purpose.

29       (2) Total revenue loss. – Tax and fee revenue projected in the county budget for  
30       FY 2024-2025 that was not realized due to the impacts of Hurricane Helene.

31       (3) Diverted funds. – The total amount of funds distributed by the Secretary of  
32       Revenue to Buncombe County under subsection (a) of this section and used



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1 for local school administrative unit operating expenses in accordance with  
2 subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of this section."
