8 "SECTION 2.1(f) The question of changing the method of election for the members 9 of the Pitt County Board of Education shall be submitted to the qualified voters of Pitt County at 10 the general election to be held on November 3, 2026, which election shall be conducted in accordance with the laws governing elections at that time. The question to be used in the voting 11 12 systems and ballots shall be:

14 Changing the method of election for the members of the Pitt County Board of Education from nonpartisan to partisan." 15

SECTION 2.1(g) The Pitt County Board of Elections shall certify the results of the 16 17 referendum conducted under subsection (f) of this section. If the certification from the Pitt County Board of Elections reflects that a majority of votes cast on the question are in favor of 18 19 the referendum set out in subsection (f) of this section, subsections (a) through (e) of this section 20 become effective the first Monday in December 2028, and in order to implement subsections (a) through (e) of this section, the 2028 elections shall be conducted as if the provisions of this 21 22 section were already in effect.

23 SECTION 2.1(h) Except as otherwise provided, this section is effective when it 24 becomes law.".
