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"SECTION 5.(c) No municipal elections shall be conducted in the City of Monroe in 2025. The terms of office for the Mayor and three Council Members in the City of Monroe serving on the effective date of this section whose terms are set to expire in 2025 shall be extended by one year. The terms of office for the three Council Members in the City of Monroe serving on the effective date of this section whose terms are set to expire in 2027 shall be extended by one year. Regular municipal elections in the City of Monroe shall resume in evennumbered years beginning in 2026 with the same staggering of terms as when elections were conducted in the odd-numbered years.

**SECTION 5.(d)** Subsection (a) of this section becomes effective at the time of the organizational meeting held in accordance with G.S. 160A-68 in December 2026. In order to implement subsection (a) of this section, the 2026 elections shall be conducted as if the provisions of subsection (a) of this section were already in effect. Subsection (c) of this section is effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held on or after that date.".
