1 moves to amend the bill on page 12, lines 19-20, by inserting between the lines the following  
2 language to read:

4 **"DEMOLITION EXCEPTION FOR BLACK MOUNTAIN HOME FOR CHILDREN**

5 **SECTION 3.6.(a)** Notwithstanding any provision of law or policy promulgated or  
6 adopted by The University of North Carolina to the contrary, qualifying structures may be  
7 demolished if approved by the Chief Financial Officer, Chancellor, and Board of Trustees of  
8 North Carolina State University. All demolition work and activities that may occur with respect  
9 to qualifying structures shall be performed in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations,  
10 rules and ordinances, including without limitation, permitting requirements. For purposes of this  
11 section, qualifying structures means up to three buildings (i) damaged as a result of Hurricane  
12 Helene, (ii) with an assessment of the damage to, and subsequent condemnation of, the structures  
13 by the State Construction Office, Department of Administration, (iii) owned by North Carolina  
14 State University, and (iv) leased to Black Mountain Home for Children as the Swannanoa 4H  
15 Camp.

16 **SECTION 3.6.(b)** This section is effective when it becomes law."
