- (6) Remote renewal or conversion. Subject to the following requirements and limitations, the Division may offer remote renewal of a drivers license or remote conversion of a full provisional license issued by the Division:
 - a. Requirements. To be eligible for remote renewal or conversion under this subdivision, a person must meet all of the following requirements:

- 4. For a remote renewal, renewal:
 - I. Of a license that complies with regulations adopted pursuant to the REAL ID Act of 2005, 49 U.S.C. § 30301, the most recent renewal was an in-person renewal and not a remote renewal under this subdivision.
 - II. Of a drivers license that is not REAL ID compliant, a person may remotely renew a license on two consecutive occasions. After two consecutive remote renewals, a non-REAL ID compliant license shall be renewed in person.
