14 **SECTION 2.(a)** There is established the Commercial Fishing Transition Fund 15 (Transition Fund) in the Office of State Treasurer. The purpose of the Transition Fund is to 16 provide funds to implement the Shrimp Trawl Transition Program created in Section 1 of this act 17 and to provide additional funds for workforce development programs provided by the 18 Community College System and for aquaculture development grants.

19 **SECTION 2.(b)** The sum of five hundred million dollars (\$500,000,000) in 20 nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year is transferred from the Savings Reserve to the 21 Commercial Fishing Transition Fund established in subsection (a) of this section. These funds 22 shall be allocated as follows:

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- (1) Two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000) to be transferred to the Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Marine Fisheries, for the Transition Payment Program established in Section 1 of this act.
- (2) Two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000) to be transferred to the Community Colleges System Office for grants under the Short-Term Workforce Development Grant Program established by G.S. 115D-5.1A for eligible persons as defined in Section 1(a) of this act and their immediate family members. The maximum award amount for persons awarded grants under this section shall, notwithstanding G.S. 115D-5.1A(c), be seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7500).





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1	(3)	Fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) to be transferred to North Carolina State
2		University for the Sea Grant program to provide the nonfederal share or cost-
3		match for existing grant programs intended to help foster the expansion of
4		sustainable U.S. marine aquaculture. If existing federal programs are not
5		funded or no grant applicants in the State are selected to receive funding,
6		North Carolina Sea Grant may reward individuals grants of no more than fifty
7		thousand dollars (\$50,000) to assist private persons, partnerships, or small
8		businesses associated with eligible persons as defined in Section 1(a) of this
9		act and their immediate family members with initial capital expenses
10		associated with a sustainable marine aquaculture operation. If North Carolina
11		Sea Grant decides to provide direct grants under this subdivision, it shall
12		develop eligibility criteria, application procedures, and time lines.
13	SECT	CION 2.(c) If House Bill 442, 2025 Regular Session, becomes law, then this

section becomes effective July 1, 2025.". 14
