2 before the period:

3 "AND TO PROVIDE FOR RESTRICTIONS ON SCHOOL SLEEPING QUARTERS";

5 and on page 7, lines 36-37, by inserting the following between the lines:

6 "SECTION 3.4.(a) Article 7B of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended
7 by adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 115C-76.110. Restrictions on sleeping quarters.**

9 (a) For the purposes of this section, the following definitions apply:

10 (1) Biological sex. – As defined in G.S. 12-3.3.

11 (2) Immediate family member. – A parent, brother, sister, or grandparent. The
12 term includes step and half relationships.

13 (3) Sleeping quarters. – A room with a bed that is intended to be used to house a
14 person overnight or other area designated for overnight sleep.

15 (b) The governing body of a public school unit shall adopt a policy that prohibits students
16 from sharing sleeping quarters with a member of the other biological sex during any activity or
17 event authorized by a school within the public school unit, except when authorized by the school
18 in either of the following circumstances:

19 (1) The parents or legal guardians of all students sharing the sleeping quarters
20 have provided written permission to the school.

21 (2) The member of the other biological sex is the student's immediate family
22 member."

23 SECTION 3.4.(b) This section is effective when it becomes law and applies
24 beginning with the 2025-2026 school year."
