1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 9, by inserting the following at the end of the line and  
2 before the period:

3 "AND TO REQUIRE THE SURRENDER OF FIREARM UPON THE ISSUANCE OF A  
4 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTIVE ORDER";

6 and on page 8, lines 3-4, by inserting the following between the lines:

7 "SECTION 4.5.(a) G.S. 50B-3 reads as rewritten:

8 "**§ 50B-3. Relief.**

9 (a) If the court, including magistrates as authorized under G.S. 50B-2(c1), finds that an  
10 act of domestic violence has occurred, the court shall grant a protective order restraining the  
11 defendant from further acts of domestic violence. A protective order shall prohibit a party from  
12 purchasing a firearm for a time fixed in the order. A protective order may include any of the  
13 following types of relief:

- 14 (1) Direct a party to refrain from such acts.
- 15 (2) Grant to a party possession of the residence or household of the parties and  
16 exclude the other party from the residence or household.
- 17 (3) Require a party to provide a spouse and his or her children suitable alternate  
18 housing.
- 19 (4) Award temporary custody of minor children and establish temporary  
20 visitation rights pursuant to G.S. 50B-2 if the order is granted ex parte, and  
21 pursuant to subsection (a1) of this section if the order is granted after notice  
22 or service of process.
- 23 (5) Order the eviction of a party from the residence or household and assistance  
24 to the victim in returning to it.
- 25 (6) Order either party to make payments for the support of a minor child as  
26 required by law.
- 27 (7) Order either party to make payments for the support of a spouse as required  
28 by law.
- 29 (8) Provide for possession of personal property of the parties, including the care,  
30 custody, and control of any animal owned, possessed, kept, or held as a pet by  
31 either party or minor child residing in the household.
- 32 (9) Order a party to refrain from doing any or all of the following:

- 2 b. Harassing the other party, including by telephone, visiting the home or
- 3 workplace, or other means.
- 4 b1. Cruelly treating or abusing an animal owned, possessed, kept, or held
- 5 as a pet by either party or minor child residing in the household.
- 6 c. Otherwise interfering with the other party.
- 7 (10) Award attorney's fees to either party.
- 8 ~~(11) Prohibit a party from purchasing a firearm for a time fixed in the order.~~
- 9 (12) Order any party the court finds is responsible for acts of domestic violence to
- 10 attend and complete an abuser treatment program if the program is approved
- 11 by the Domestic Violence Commission.
- 12 (13) Include any additional prohibitions or requirements the court deems necessary
- 13 to protect any party or any minor child.

15 **SECTION 4.5.(b)** This section becomes effective December 1, 2025, and applies to  
16 orders issued on or after that date."
