  - SECTION 3.(a) G.S. 143-136(a2) reads as rewritten:

12 "(a2) Process for Appointments by the Governor. – The Governor shall transmit to the 13 presiding officers of the Senate and the House of Representatives, within four weeks of the 14 convening of the session of the General Assembly in the year for which the terms in question are initially appointed or are to expire, the names of the persons to be appointed by the Governor and 15 submitted to the General Assembly for confirmation by joint resolution. If an appointment is 16 17 required pursuant to this subsection when the General Assembly is not in session, the member may be appointed and serve on an interim basis pending confirmation by the General Assembly. 18 19 For the purpose of this subsection, the General Assembly is not in session only (i) prior to 20 convening of the regular session, (ii) during any adjournment of the regular session for more than 10-90 days, or (iii) after sine die adjournment of the regular session." 21

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**SECTION 3.(b)** G.S. 143-136.1(b1) reads as rewritten:

23 "(b1) Process for Appointments by the Governor. - The Governor shall transmit to the presiding officers of the Senate and the House of Representatives, within four weeks of the 24 25 convening of the session of the General Assembly in the year for which the terms in question are initially appointed or are to expire, the names of the persons to be appointed by the Governor and 26 27 submitted to the General Assembly for confirmation by joint resolution. If an appointment is required pursuant to this subsection when the General Assembly is not in session, the member 28 29 may be appointed and serve on an interim basis pending confirmation by the General Assembly. For the purpose of this subsection, the General Assembly is not in session only (i) prior to 30 convening of the regular session, (ii) during any adjournment of the regular session for more than 31 32 10-90 days, or (iii) after sine die adjournment of the regular session."
