RULES FOR CONSIDERING AMENDMENTS

February 5, 2025

If amendments are offered, then the following rules must be met in order for the amendment to be eligible for consideration:

- 1) Amendments may not increase total spending beyond the amounts appropriated in the Disaster Recovery Act of 2025 – Part I.
- 2) Amendments where money is being transferred among items must clearly identify the items/programs that are being increased and decreased.
- 3) Amendments affecting spending may only be nonrecurring.
- 4) Amendments that adjust any Fund or Reserve except for SERDRF and the Helene Fund are not allowed.
- 5) Amendments may not adjust prior appropriations from the SERDRF or Helene Fund in S.L. 2024-51, S.L. 2024-53, and S.L. 2024-57.
- 6) Amendments may not include fees or other Finance-related matters.
- 7) Amendments must be germane to Helene disaster recovery.
- 8) Amendment requests must be received by Bill Drafting staff by 1:00 pm on Monday, February 10.
