H307-ATCe-23 [v.10] Principal Clerk) Page 1 of 2 Amends Title [YES] ,2025 Third Edition Senator Mohammed moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 12, by inserting the following immediately after the word "SUPERVISION;" "TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF A DECEASED CRIME VICTIM'S NAME, IMAGE, OR LIKENESS IN POLITICAL ADVERTISEMENTS;"; and on page 16, lines 47-48, by inserting the following between those lines: "USE OF A DECEASED CRIME VICTIM'S NAME, IMAGE, OR LIKENESS IN POLITICAL ADVERTISEMENTS **SECTION 8.5(a)** Article 22A of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Part to read: "Part 1B. Prohibition on Use of a Deceased Crime Victim's Name, Image, or Likeness. "§ 163-278.39G. Prohibition on use of a deceased crime victim's name, image, or likeness in political advertising. Definitions. – (a) Deceased crime victim. – An individual whose proximate cause of death was (1) an alleged crime. Immediate family member. – A spouse, child, sibling, parent, grandparent, or (2) grandchild of the deceased crime victim. This term includes stepparents, stepchildren, stepsiblings, and adoptive relationships. Name, image, or likeness. - Any written, visual, or auditory attribute of a <u>(3)</u> deceased crime victim that serves to identify that victim to an ordinary, reasonable reader, viewer, or listener, regardless of the medium that captures the attribute. Political advertising. – An advertisement made by any of the following: <u>(4)</u> Any person or entity regulated by or required to file reports to the State Board of Elections or the Federal Elections Commission. Any organization exempt from taxation under sections 501(c)(3) or b. 501(c)(4) of the United States Internal Revenue Code. In accordance with the recognition in the State Constitution that crime victims shall (b)



be treated with dignity and respect, it is further declared to be the public policy of this State that

14	contributions received as a result of the political advertisement to the Crime Victims			
15	Compensation Fund.			
16	(f) Nothing in this section shall create any liability for acts by the publisher, owner, agent			
17	or employee of a newspaper, periodical, radio station, television station, cable-television system			
18	or other advertising medium arising out of the publication or dissemination of any advertisement			
19	governed by this section, when the publisher, owner, agent or employee did not know that the			
20	advertisement violated the requirements of this section."			
21	SECTION 8.5.(b) This section becomes effective October 1, 2025, and applies to			
22	advertisements published on or after that date.".
