OVERVIEW: Sec. 8.11 of S.L. 2016-94 provides that, beginning with the 2016-2017 school year and for subsequent school years thereafter, the following schools can operate as cooperative innovative high schools even though they were not provided with additional operating funds:

- Alexander Early College.
- Cabarrus Early College of Technology.
- Camden Early College.
- Chatham County School of Science and Engineering.
- City of Medicine Cooperative Innovative High School.
- Gaston Early College High School.
- Hillside New Tech Cooperative Innovative High School.
- Johnston County Career and Technical Academy.
- Northampton County New Tech Early College.
- Person Early College for Innovation and Leadership.
- Stanly County School of Engineering and Design.
- Wayne School of Engineering at Goldsboro High School.
