SUMMARY: House Joint Resolution 1147 provides for the confirmation of the reappointment of James L. Gale as a Special Superior Court Judge.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 7A-45.1(a10) directs the Governor to appoint Special Superior Court Judges subject to confirmation by the General Assembly by joint resolution. The term of office for the judge is five years.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Joint Resolution 1147 confirms the Governor's reappointment of James L. Gale as a Special Superior Court Judge for a term of five years beginning on May 17, 2016 and expiring on May 16, 2021.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Effective upon ratification.
