SUMMARY: *House Joint Resolution 132 rescinds all applications that the General Assembly has made to Congress to call a convention to propose amendments to the United States Constitution. In the resolution, the General Assembly urges the legislatures of every State that has applied to Congress to call a convention to repeal and withdraw the applications. It requires the Secretary of State to send a certified copy of this resolution to the secretary of state of each state, to the presiding officers of the chambers of the legislatures of each state, to the Secretary of the United States Senate, to the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, to the members of Congress representing this State, and to the Administrator of the U.S. General Services Administration.*

EFFECTIVE DATE: Effective upon ratification
