# HOUSE BILL 20: Reegan's Rule/Childhood Diabetes Education

**SUMMARY:** *The PCS to House Bill 20 would require parent education during certain well child visits regarding Type I diabetes.*

[As introduced, this bill was identical to S27, as introduced by Sen. Smith, which is currently in Senate Health Care.]

### BILL ANALYSIS:

The PCS to House Bill 20 would require that each physician, physician assistant, or certified nurse practitioner who provides well-child care to ensure that he or she provides education on the warning signs and symptoms of Type I diabetes. This education must take place with each parent for each child under the care of the health care provider at least once at birth, twelve months of age, and at twenty-four months of age of the child.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act becomes effective October 1, 2015.
