**SUMMARY:** *House Bill 311 would authorize the Town of Leland to hold an ABC store election if the Town has 1,000 registered voters.*

**CURRENT LAW:** Currently, a city may hold an ABC store election only if:

- 1) The city has at least 1,000 registered voters; and
- 2) The county in which the city is located does not operate ABC stores.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 311 would authorize the Town of Leland to hold an ABC store election if the Town has at least 1,000 registered voters.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** House Bill 311 would become effective when it becomes law.
