SUMMARY: House Bill 311 would authorize the Town of Leland to hold an ABC store election if the Town has 1,000 registered voters.

CURRENT LAW: Currently, a city may hold an ABC store election only if:

1) The city has at least 1,000 registered voters; and

2) The county in which the city is located does not operate ABC stores.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 311 would authorize the Town of Leland to hold an ABC store election if the Town has at least 1,000 registered voters.

EFFECTIVE DATE: House Bill 311 would become effective when it becomes law.
