Emergency Medical Service Personnel Technical Changes

SUMMARY: S.L. 2015-290 makes technical and conforming changes to the statutes governing the regulation of emergency medical personnel services to reflect new national standards and directs the North Carolina Medical Care Commission to amend its applicable rules consistent with the changes in the law.

This act became effective October 29, 2015.

BILL ANALYSIS: S.L. 2015-290 makes technical and conforming changes to the name of certain EMS personnel in Article 7 of Chapter 131E of the General Statutes (Regulation of Emergency Medical Services) to reflect and conform to EMS personnel licensure levels in the <u>National Emergency Medical Personnel Education Standards</u> of the National Highway Transportation Safety Administration.

The act also directs the North Carolina Medical Care Commission to amend its applicable rules consistent with the changes in the act by December 31, 2015.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective October 29, 2015.
