

HOUSE BILL 594: Motor Vehicle Dealer Document Retention/Inspection/Format.

OVERVIEW: S.L. 2016-74 makes changes to the law governing motor vehicle dealer record retention.

This act became effective June 30, 2016.

CURRENT LAW: Under current law, motor vehicle dealers must keep a copy of records of all vehicles received and sold by the dealer, and make them available to DMV for inspection.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 594 modifies State law as follows:

- Authorizes the motor vehicle records to be kept in electronic form.
- Authorizes the records to be kept by a third party.
- Requires DMV to adopt rules consistent with the bill, without the requirement for a fiscal analysis of the rule.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective June 30, 2016.
