SUMMARY: House Bill 724 increases the membership of the NC Medical Board by one to ensure that at least one physician assistant and one nurse practitioner are members of the Board.

CURRENT LAW:

The NC Medical Board currently consists of 12 members. One member must be a physician assistant or a nurse practitioner.

BILL ANALYSIS:

House Bill 724 amends G.S. 90-2(a) which provides for the North Carolina Medical Board. The bill increases the board membership from 12 to 13 members. The new member ensures that the composition of the Medical Board includes both a physician assistant and a nurse practitioner.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This bill would become effective when it becomes law.
