

HOUSE BILL 872: Administrative Law Judges' Salaries

SUMMARY: House Bill 872 adjusts the salaries of administrative law judges. The salary of the Chief Administrative Law Judge shall be the same as superior court judges (was district court judges). The salary of a Senior Administrative Law Judge shall be the same as district attorneys (was 95% of the salary of the Chief Administrative Law Judge). The salary of other administrative law judges shall be the same as district court judges (was 90% of the salary of the Chief Administrative Law Judge).

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
