**SUMMARY:** *Sec. 20.2 of S.L. 2015-241, as amended by Sec. 90.2 of S.L. 2015-264, allows patients, health care providers, and pharmacists to synchronize filling multiple prescription drugs under health insurance plans that provide prescription drug coverage. Certain conditions apply including: the medications are covered by the clinical drug coverage; the medications must be for the treatment of a chronic illness and subject to refill; and the medications are not for Schedule II or Schedule III drugs.*

*This section becomes effective August 1, 2016, and applies to insurance contracts issued, renewed, or amended on or after that date.*
