SUMMARY: *House Joint Resolution 978 provides for the confirmation of the appointment of William "Bill" Daughtridge to the North Carolina Industrial Commission. His term will expire April 30, 2019.*

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 97-77 creates a six member North Carolina Industrial Commission. Members are appointed by the Governor for six-year terms, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Joint Resolution 978 confirms the Governor's appointment of William "Bill" Daughtridge to the Industrial Commission to fill a vacancy on the Commission left by the resignation of Drew Heath. The appointment is for a term beginning February 18, 2016, and expiring April 30, 2019.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The resolution becomes effective upon ratification.
